12. A discussion of delegated powers and the suspension of public meetings of SPC in view of the Covid-19 crisis follows. Councillors vote unanimously to adopt the policy re delegated powers and to suspend public meetings for the foreseeable future, for the safety of councillors and members of the public. 15. Main item for discussion not on the agenda, for both councillors and public, is the Covid-19 crisis and SPC setting up a Volunteer Support group in the village involving Stockbury Church, represented by Rev Julian Staniforth.

There followed the main part of the meeting, a discussion with input from the public attending, about the setting up of the Covid-19 support group, the form it should take, what may be needed by villagers, shopping, collection of prescriptions, telephone support etc and who will be involved. Rev Staniforth informs the meeting he is a voucher holder for Sittingbourne Food bank so has access to the foodbank if required by any villager. Dave suggests the mini bus phone can be used for the support group as a main communication point. A sum of £2000 can be made available, if required, by SPC to fund the support activities of the volunteer group, obtain provisions and essentials etc if required.

A meeting to set up the volunteer organisation is arranged for 11am Friday 20th March in the village hall.
